# About The Catalogue

We open as usual with a short section on industry, engineering and commerce, together with some canal and commercial shipping books. The main British and Irish section starts at #89 and notes on some of the contributing collections might be of interest. *Geoffrey Cupit* was the son of the well known Mansfield photographer and writer Jack Cupit - a regular contributor to *Trains Illustrated* in the 1950s. Geoff spent much of his life as an academic abroad but in the last years of his life lived at Feering in Essex. A large part of his vast collection consisted of English topography and medieval history (a temptation resisted - this house has an embarrassment of books already) but enough good railway literature was found to fill the car. Our thanks to Mark Cupit who arranged the transaction.

Another sad departure was *Ernie Dunsford*, whom we first knew as a customer perhaps 35 or 40 years ago when he was still a squadron leader in the RAF. He then dropped off the radar but suddenly reappeared about 2010 as a major collector of postcards as well as books on railways, and tramways. Ernie's postcard interests were wide and included station views, tramways and preserved railways and in a few short years he amassed some 12-15,000 examples. We bought the best of the books and I believe the postcards went to auction. Farewell Ernie, a good friend.

Another customer and catalogue subscriber way back was *Jon Condell* from Holywood, Northern Ireland. Jon was an occasional caller at Station House and we last met on the final PTG rail tour of Portugal in 2012 when he was in his usual high spirits. He bought Airey/Railway Clearing House maps, bound sets, and anything of Irish interest. Most of the maps are listed in Section 3, apart from a few requiring binder's attention. We did not get the Irish books and documents, which were probably sold locally. The fine run of Trains Illustrated at #536 was also Jon's, having been assembled by us for him in the 1990s.

During the Summer we visited our good friends *Stan & Val Friedman* and bought a few of their duplicates. Stan was already established as a bookseller/collector when I started trading in the mid-1970s and for many years he and Val ran the highly successful bi-annual Islington and Camden collectors' fairs. We were able to buy some classic first editions as well as the scarce Parliamentary and Board of Trade reports listed at #455-470.

Just as we were tying up the catalogue loose ends we were offered the collection of the late **Derek Middleton**, from which we made a good selection. They arrived too late to go in the alphabetical listings and the best of them are gathered in Section 4 (#606-656) together with a few other properties. Mr Middleton, who was a British Rail architect, lived in Rickmansworth in the heart of Metroland. It is not a part of the country I know particularly well but I can see its attractions. One almost expected Sir John Betjeman to emerge from the laurel hedges.

Turning to the foreign books in Section 5, by far the largest contribution was from the library of *Michael Burberry*. For many years Mr Burberry was the leading British collector of

German railway literature, being particularly active in the 1990s when I was dispersing the vast Patterson-Rutherford collection. In particular he bought P-R's entire holding of pre-war Reichsbahn time tables. These seem to be extremely scarce in the UK and we were pleased to see them return once more. The Burberry collection had a good stock of the Eisenbahn-Kurier and Transpress locomotive class histories, and a number of books on military railways, armoured trains and railway guns, not all of them easy to find in this country. Another real rarity is the 7-volume history of the railways of the Austro-Hungarian Monarchy (#835). This was one of two sets sold from the Fred Haut library and not seen again until now.

There is no large bargain offering this time but it is worth looking at Section 6 where a number of box lots of booklets, magazines, unbound sets of *The Locomotive*, and suchlike, can be seen. This is part of my programme for emptying our cellar at home in which thousands of magazines ended up during the last desperate weeks vacating Station House in 2016. The final lot in this section is a large unsorted accumulation of *Railway Observer* offered free to anyone prepared to remove them from the cellar, in exchange for a suitable (modest) donation to a railway charity of the acquirer's choice.

## George Smiley Goes West

Old Luddite's current book at bedtime is John Le Carré's novel *A Murder Of Quality* (1962), in which the anti-hero George Smiley makes his second appearane in print. The opening sentence of Chapter 3 reads "The seven-five from Waterloo to Yeovil is not a popular train, though it provides an excellent breakfast." A cheering thought in these troubling times yet, having long been a devotee of both dining cars and breakfast, I detected a false note. In my experience breakfast was not a strong point of the Southern Region, at least not on the Western Division. Generally speaking Waterloo liked to see the rails well aired before sending its dining cars forth, and early risers could either have breakfast at home or go hungry. The extreme example was the up Atlantic Coast Express, where the Padstow portion departed at 0933 but the passengers didn't get a sniff at the diner until beyond Exeter three hours later. In effect it was a Luncheon Car Express, as the Great Central would have called it.

So what does the 1960 Southern Region time table book (996 pages, one shilling), Table 35, have to say? First of course there is no 0705 service. Trains from Waterloo to beyond Salisbury departed on the hour, every other hour. There weren't that many of them and the first was the 0900, which did include a full restaurant car, but it didn't reach Yeovil Junction until midday and rather late for the purposes of the plot. Artistic license is permissible in novels of course but it behoves the author to get the factual detail right. Readers would howl in derision if for example James Bond wielded a blunderbuss or drove a Morris Oxford.

To go off at a complete tangent (and why not?), had Smiley read the opening pages of his trusty SR book he would have found numerous facilities that were perfectly normal in those days of the universal railway but have no place today. We have lost: circular tour tickets, evening excursions, tours by rail - road - steamer, party travel, guaranteed excursions, free tickets for organisers, Pullman cars, passengers' luggage in advance, insurance, proper restaurant cars, packed meals, British Transport Hotels, camping coaches, parcels by passenger train, cartage, warehouse accommodation for traders, farm removals (with livestock fed and watered en route and milked when necessary), films and filmstrips, fares

clearly stated, addresses of connecting bus companies, and the names of all the chief regional officers. And not least, the time books themselves.

Professional railwaymen will say this is all nostalgic stuff and nonsense, pointing to faster and much more frequent trains, smarter staff, fewer accidents, and hundreds of renovated stations. But I think we *have* lot something and we must see whether the review of the extravagant franchising system brings any real changes.

#### Out And About

Railway activities this year were limited to two long tours by road in Scotland and Wales, as usual in search of surviving traditional infrastructure and anything else that caught our fancy. In June we extended our usual three or four days in Edinburgh to fifteen days so as to cover as much as we could in the Highlands. Things didn't work out quite as planned, though we managed to clock up more than 1,600 miles, reaching as far north at Brora. My tour notes exceed forty pages and there is only space here to mention a selection.

One day in Edinburgh was spent on further research for my Hawthorns Of Leith project, the staff at Edinburgh Central Library being efficient and helpful as usual. Then it was off to Elgin to start the tour proper. Of the two railways that were our chief interest, the Highland Railway and the Great North of Scotland Railway, the Highland has fared much the better. While all nine branches are long since closed, of the main lines only the old road from Aviemore to Forres has been lost. Over 76% of the 1922 total of 561 miles remains in use, a higher percentage than most pre-grouping companies. By contrast the only surviving section of the GNSR is the 53 miles from Aberdeen to Keith together with the 12 miles of the Keith & Dufftown private railway. Many traditional stations have survived at both open and closed locations. Many have been converted to private residencies, pubs and bars or, as at Strathpeffer, craft retail outlets and generally they are looked after well.

One station severely at risk is the Newtyle terminus of the Dundee & Newtyle Railway. This is the oldest recognisable railway station building (1831) in Scotland and the third oldest in the whole of Great Britain. Only Heighington (1827) and Manchester Liverpool Road (1830) are older. The building, effectively a small train shed, was abandoned as a goods depot in the early 1960s. Despite being a listed Ancient Monument no maintenance has been done for many years and it is smothered in vegetation. There are the usual problems of blocked gutters, broken doors and windows, and pigeon infestation. My letter drawing attention to the historic importance of Newtyle was published as a short feature in the *Dundee Courier* but whether it will have any effect remains to be seen.

Traditional signalling has disappeared from much of the Highlands and the rest will probably not last much longer. I bagged the last GNSR boxes at Dyce, Inverurie, Insch, Keith Junction and the closed box at Elgin Centre (formerly Elgin West Joint), though I missed Kennethmont. There are still a few boxes on the Highland Main Line and I managed to pick off most of those not seen before including Dalwhinnie, Blair Atholl, Kingussie, and the disused boxes at Carr Bridge and Nairn East. Oh, and I should not omit the tiny box at Clachnaharry just outside Inverness where the railway crosses the Caledonian Canal. The swing bridge here I had previously overlooked, and this now makes the total of operable British railway swing bridges eight.

Another of my objectives was to photograph some of the many bridges and viaducts, and here we had mixed results. In some places such has been the unchecked growth of tree cover that it is impossible to find an unobstructed viewpoint. We wasted a lot of time on the impressive Spey Bay viaduct at Garmouth and on the River Tilt lattice girder bridge at Blair Atholl, with no result. But we did better with the magnificent Culloden Viaduct, the longest in Scotland, and Logierait Viaduct on the trackbed of the Aberfeldy branch. At Moy is the last wooden bridge on Network Rail. It is right beside the A9 and the job was done in five minutes.

We also visited some more railway hotels. We stayed at the Station Hotel, Perth, the Dornoch Hotel (HR) and had lunch at the Highland Hotel, Strathpeffer (also HR). The score is now 34 out of the fifty or so still extant.

South Wales in September, a gloriously warm week in an otherwise wet autumn. Such changes since I was last there in 1963. All the collieries and most of the other industries have vanished and the once bare hills are thick with tree growth. Stations in South Wales were always a prosaic bunch and even on surviving lines have been swept away ruthlessly. Large multi-platform stations such as Tondu, Penarth and Merthyr have been reduced to one platform, though the last named has a good, modern, interpretation of a Brunel style chalet ticket office. The best remaining stations include Cardiff Central, 1920s neo-Georgian with GREAT WESTERN RAILWAY cut irremovably into the Portland stone frontage; Cardiff Bay (formerly Bute Road) where the ancient Taff Vale general offices are newly restored; Abergavenny and Pontrilas, both on the North & West Line; Bridgend, still partly Brunelian; and Tenby, still showing its Pembroke & Tenby origins. Other fragments survive at Llandaff and Caerphilly.

Mechanical signalling is nearing extinction. We found the surviving signal boxes at Park Junction, Aberthaw East (last Barry Railway box), Tondu, Pembrey, Lanelli West, Ferryside, Abergavenny, Pontrilas and Tram Inn. Unfortunately a break in the weather on our last day prevented us visiting the GW/LNW boxes between Hereford and Shrewsbury. They are among the oldest in the country and we hope to look at them early in 2020.

The last surviving railway hotel in South Wales is the GWR Fishguard Bay Hotel. We stayed one night there but it has fallen on hard times and there must be some doubt as to its long term future. We also photographed the two Taff Vale Railway hotels at Penarth, the Penarth Hotel (now a special school) and the Marine Hotel (listed Grade II but burnt out, derelict and probably beyond economic repair). Of pubs with railway names there are shoals still, and too many to enumerate. The Barry Railway offices at Barry Docks are magnificent.

Bourne's masterly survey of the London & Birmingham project was undertaken during the construction of the line. Many of the prints show the making of the great cuttings, embankments, and tunnels, employing only primitive methods. Others show completed stations, bridges and viaducts in largely pastoral settings, in great contrast with today where two thirds of the route is now urbanised. This is the best record we have of the building of an early trunk line.

At the time of publication the greatest history of any railway system, and even now only rivalled by the five-volume Swiss railway set. Fifty-two authors and editors contributed to the work, most of them senior railwaymen. The first four volumes (five books) appeared in 1898 and the work at that point was regarded as complete. In 1908, however, a further two volumes appeared in matching bindings. As well as covering developments in the decade since 1898 there were additional chapters on subjects such as light railways, military railway engineering, electric traction, station layouts and architecture that were not dealt with in the original work.
